- The West Australian Government requires payment of \$Au 176 in Year 11 and \$Au 424 in Year 12 for registration of subjects of all Year 11 and 12 Tertiary Entrance Examinations (TEE) students with the Curriculum Council of Western Australia (CCWA). Students in lower years choosing to study Curriculum Council units will be charged \$17.50 per unit.
- The cost for students studying Vocational Education Training (VET) in Years 11 and 12 - approximately \$Au 225.00 per annum.
- The Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is a further Government requirement. This charge is subject to change by the Health Care Provider.
- Families will be asked to contribute on a one-off basis to the Mercy College Building Fund.
- Upon receipt of payment of first semester fees - \$Au 6,000 Secondary, \$Au 3,000 Primary, the student's details will be lodged electronically with the Department of Education Science & Training (DEST) and if successful an electronic confirmation of enrolment (eCoE) will be issued, a copy of which will be forwarded to the prospective student. The student then lodges the eCoE together with all other required documentation with the Department of Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs (DMIA) for a Visa to be issued.
- Balance of \$Au 6,000 (secondary) \$Au 3,000 (primary) for second semester is payable in advance by the last day of first semester.
- Students are responsible for the purchase of their own textbooks and uniforms. These items can be ordered and purchased from the Mercy Shop which is situated on the College Campus.
- Students re-enrolling for the following year, one semester's fees must be paid by **30 October** of the current year.

**Please note:** *Payment made after the commencement of semester will attract a Late Payment Fee of \$Au 200.00.*
