

2022 MUSIC YEAR 7 SCHOLARSHIPS



Mercy College is offering Music Scholarships to Year 7 students in 2022 for flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, bass guitar or voice. Scholarships include part or full remission of tuition fees and the cost of instrumental hire. Applicants may be ongoing or beginner students as prior music experience is not necessary for a music scholarship position.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

- The instrument/ voice may be the students first or second instrument.
- In the case of the instrument being the student's second instrument they must agree to play this instrument in a band or ensemble situation over their first instrument if required.
- Participation in our College ensembles is expected when the Music Manager and the tutor believe the student has achieved an appropriate standard.
- Vocal scholarships are offered to students who wish to partake of voice tuition and participation in our Mercy Choir is required.
- Tuition involves a compulsory 30-minute lesson each school week during school time, which is timetabled on a rotational basis so that there is minimum impact on class work.
- Students will be provided with an instrument and resources if required.
- Students are expected to practise daily.
- Students are required to remain in the program for a minimum of 2 years.
- Students are expected to keep up with their academic studies.
- Students are expected to enrol in Music as a subject in their option selection if offered.
- Students must maintain Good Standing
- Students will need to have the support of their family.
- Families are expected to be active members of, and support the Friends of Mercy Music.

Scholarships may be withdrawn if the above conditions are not met

On receipt of the application form, shortlisted students will be contacted to attend an interview with their parent(s) and the Music Manager.
